Recycling swipe cards are now available for all residents at the Somerset Township Community Center located at 223 South Main Street. Cards may be picked up Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

In order to collect your swipe card, proof of residency at The Pinnacle will be required. Please present your driver's license, tax slips, utility bill, or other form of evidence when obtaining your card.

Recycling swipe cards are issued free of charge to all residents of The Pinnacle at Duxton. However, there will be a charge of \$25 for the replacement of lost or damaged cards. Please note that cards may ONLY be used by the person whose name is printed on the card.

The Somerset Township Recycling Program will commence operation on April 12. The center will be open according to the schedule published on our website, with fees applicable after the fourth drop-off of each month.
